Regulations for Outside Contractors

- 1. Outside contractors must have current insurance that included the following:
 - a. General Liability \$1,000,000 (coverage for third party damage)
 - b. Marine Operators Legal Liability \$1,000,000 (coverage for damage to other people's vessels in other people's care)
 - c. Protection Indemnity \$1,000,000 (coverage for operating vessels or working on vessels in the water)
- 2. Working hours are from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Monday through Thursday.
- 3. Parking of contractor vehicles are only allowed in areas designated by Deltaville Yachting Center.
- 4. Work is to be conducted in designated work areas.
- 5. A marina employee may supervise the work area at any time during repairs to safeguard marina property and ensure that safety regulations are followed. Contractors will be charged current yard rates for this supervision.
- 6. Proof of Workman's Compensation insurance must be on file at DYC or if the contractor does not have Workman's Compensation they must sign a waiver. This waiver will be kept on file at DYC.
- 7. Contractors will be charged for any clean up deemed necessary after repairs are completed.
- 8. Outside contractors employed by DYC marina customers will be assessed a \$15 fee per work order per boat. Outside contractors <u>MUST</u> sign the Contractor's Log before beginning work and pay the \$15 fee at that time. If the above rules are not followed the fee increases to \$30 per boat per day and it may result in DYC denying you access to DYC marina property.
