

Sharon Day Retires from Catalina Yachts

A legacy of quality of integrity

A big part of the ‘heart’ of Catalina Yachts has always been Sharon Day. If you have attended any Annapolis Sailboat Show, you most likely have been greeted by Sharon’s big smile of gratitude. Sharon loves Catalina owners.

Sharon Day started her career with Catalina Yachts in July 1974. However, her boating career began in August 1965 on Lake Erie. She started with a 28-foot wooden Larson sailboat, powered by an inboard Albin engine, that she kept on the Grand River in Ohio.

Sharon’s favorite part of working at Catalina Yachts was working in an industry she was passionate about. She has always loved sailing and being on the water, so every day felt like a dream job. As for challenges—there really weren’t any. Sharon feels strongly that ‘when you love what you do, even the tough parts don’t feel difficult.’

One of Sharon’s favorite parts of work, was playing jokes on Catalina Yachts Founder, Frank Butler. Sharon remembers fondly, ‘he really got a kick out of them’.

Sharon started boating in 1965, retired in 2024, and still loves it. Whether it’s on a lake, the ocean, or the Gulf of Mexico, she will always enjoy being on the water.

Sharon’s career with Catalina Yachts began in Woodland Hills, California, on Victory Boulevard, where she worked for almost 47 years. Eventually, Catalina moved operations to Largo, Florida, with Sharon relocating to St. Petersburg to be close to the new plant.

The industry was certainly male dominated, but Sharon found that many women were equally passionate about sailing and being on the water. Sharon mentioned that ‘Women have a strong desire to learn how to handle boats, ensuring they can manage emergencies’.

Sharon Day’s dedication and hard work paid off. She was the first woman to serve a three-year term as a director on the Southern California Marine Association Board.

Sharon started her career at Catalina as a billing clerk. After 47 years, she became the President and CEO. Her inspiration came from working in an industry she loved. Being around sailboats and on the water every day. As Sharon says ‘It doesn’t get much better than that!’
